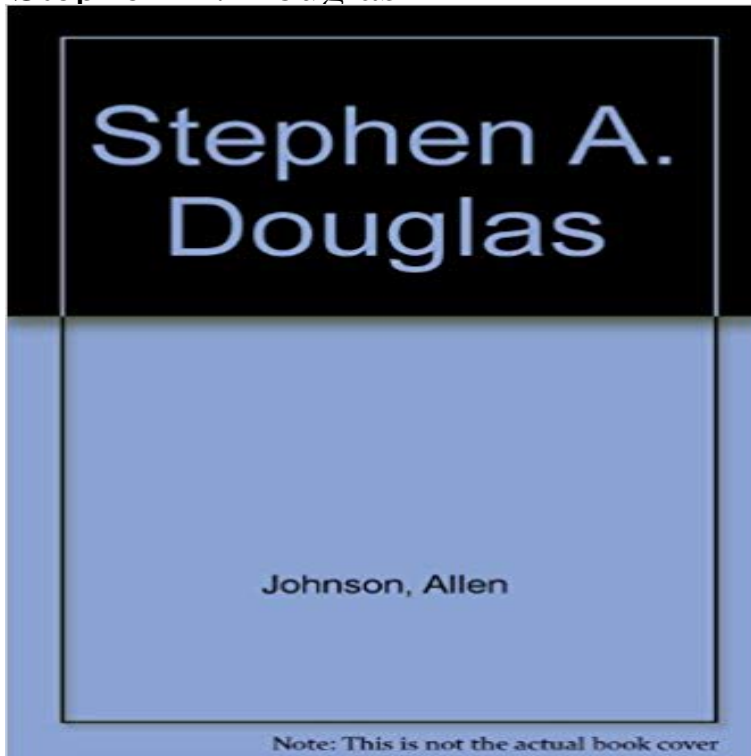


Stephen A. Douglas
