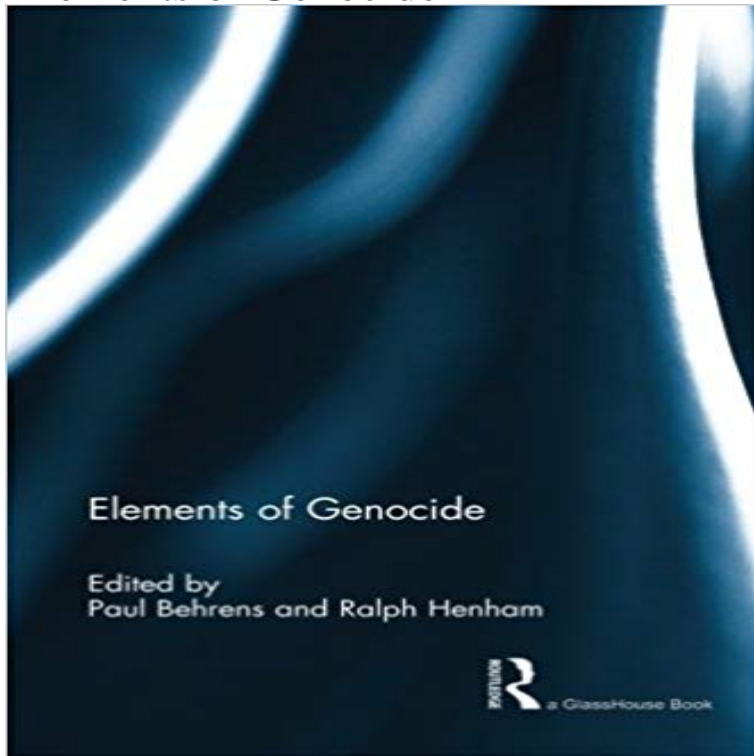


## Elements of Genocide
