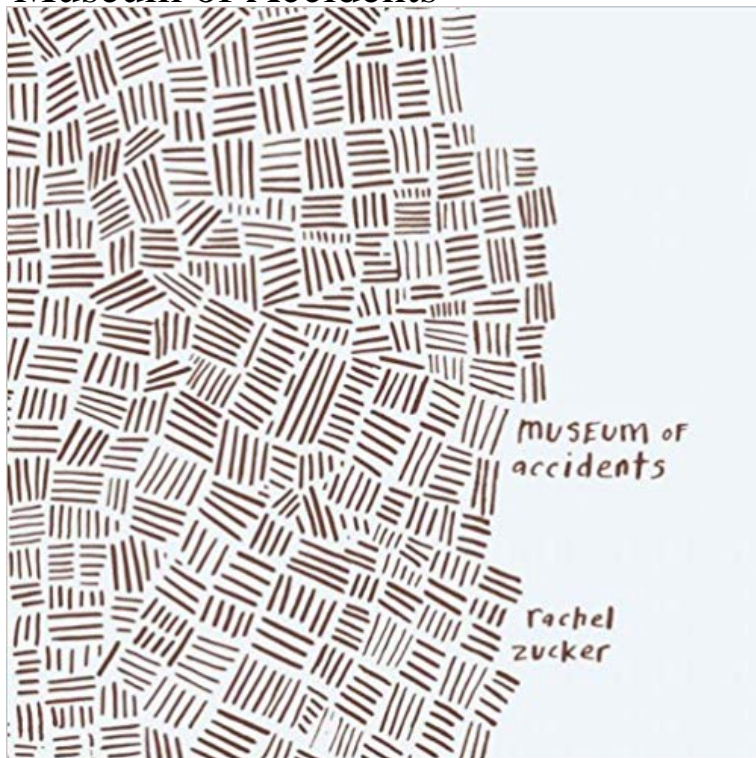


Museum of Accidents
