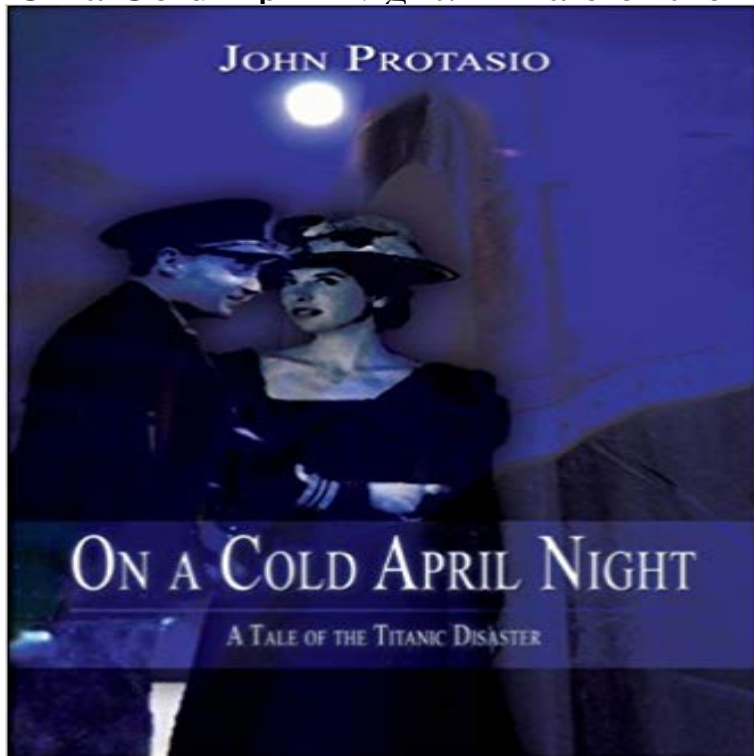


## On a Cold April Night: A Tale of the Titanic Disaster
